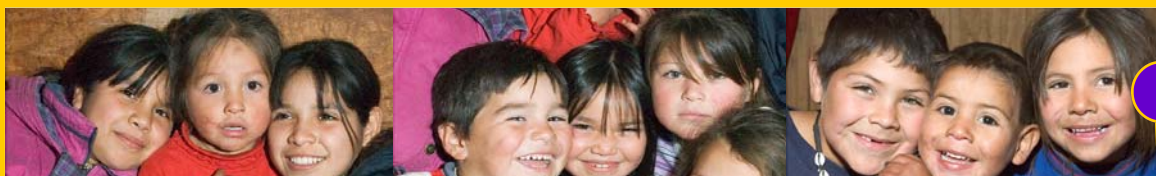

ELIGIBILITY:

1. Persons currently working in social services, health care and related areas in American Indian/Alaska Native communities
2. 9-month commitment to program:
 - Letter from participant agreeing to the 9-month commitment and agreeing to provide training to local staff.
 - Letter/sign off by supervisor or employer approving the participant's 9-month commitment to program.

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

1. Participants will be trained in the prevention and treatment of child abuse and neglect, and
2. After completion of training, the participants will return to their respective communities and, with the support of their employer, train at least three local persons in the prevention and treatment of child abuse & neglect.
3. Participants will facilitate evaluation of the project.
